

## About World ATM Congress

World ATM Congress is the world's largest air traffic management event. It combines a large-scale exhibition, world-class conference, and premier networking opportunities that allow participants to exchange knowledge about the latest air traffic management trends and developments and build career-long relationships that help foster innovation and collaboration in the aviation industry. World ATM Congress, now in its fourth year, is produced by the Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation (CANSO) in partnership with the Air Traffic Control Association (ATCA).

The event takes place 8-10 March at IFEMA, Feria de Madrid and includes representatives from every segment within aviation:

- 79 air navigation service providers.
- Aviation leaders from 125 countries, including high-ranking regulators and officials; armed forces; NGOs; CEOs of airports and airlines; manufacturers; trade associations; and leaders of the commercial companies that provide products and services to the aviation industry.
- A record-breaking 225 exhibitors, an increase of 22 since last year will display their products and services.

Experts from 55 organizations from all sectors of the aviation industry are delivering over [80 hours of programming](#) across five education theatres. These include product demonstrations and launches, panel discussions, and presentations on recent trends and developments.

The theme of the [Conference of World ATM Congress](#) is *Leadership, Change, and Implementation*. Four sessions over two mornings explore the industry leadership challenges that ANSPs, airlines, and airports currently face, as well as a glimpse at what the industry will have implemented in the next five years. Industry leaders will examine the impact of new technologies, such as remote towers, and new entrants to airspace, including remotely piloted aircraft systems and commercial space vehicles.
